

To upload a photo, go to the blue **photos** tab of your **activity page**.



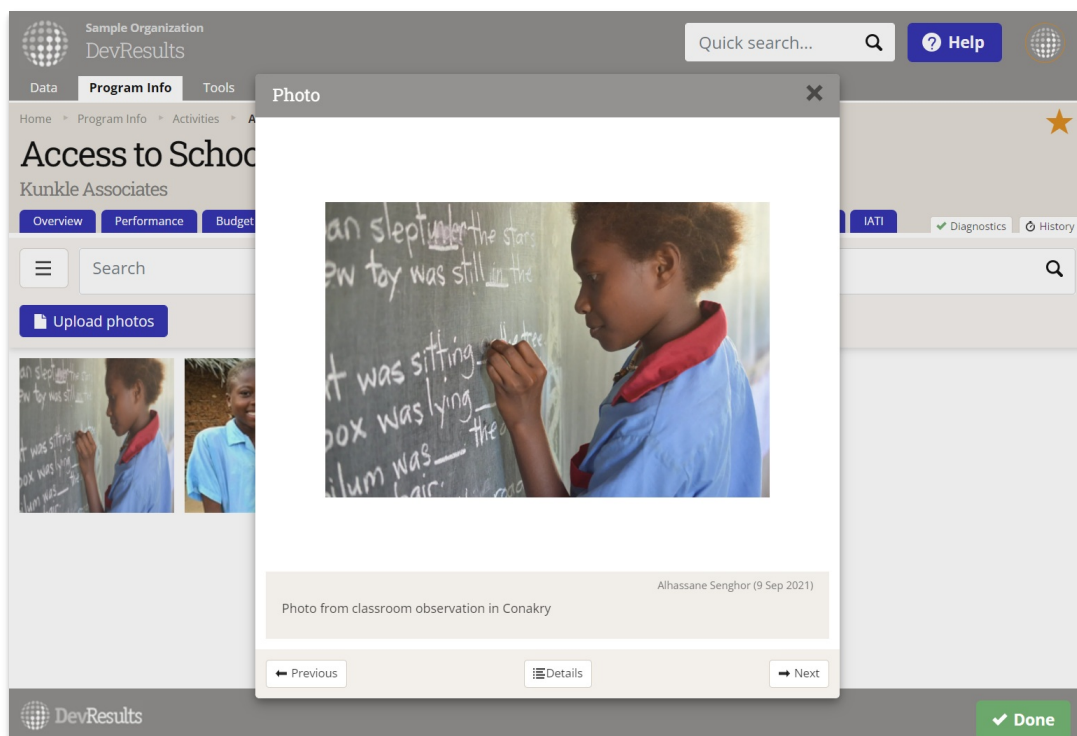

Click on **Details** to view and edit photo metadata, or to download the full size image.

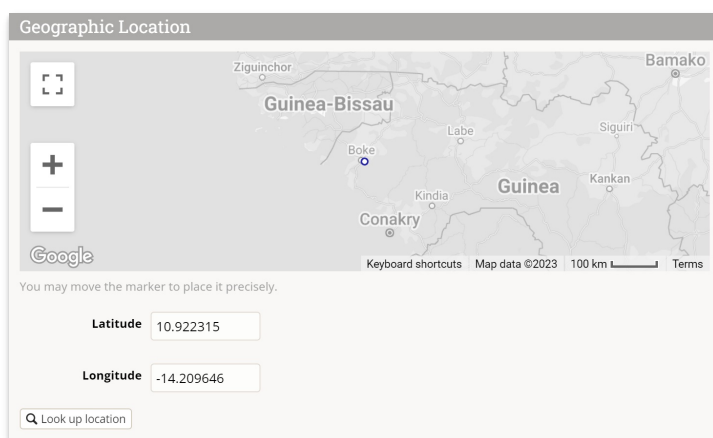
In the **Description** section of the Details page, you can edit the following fields:

- **Caption:** This adds context for the photo and appears on the image preview page.
- **ALT text:** This description is used by screen readers for the visually impaired.
- **Photo credit:** The person or organization who provided the photo.
- **Date:** Date of photo.
- **Tags:** Group photos thematically by adding **tags**.
- **Location:** Identify the location associated with the photo (to be used by the geography filter on the Photo index page).

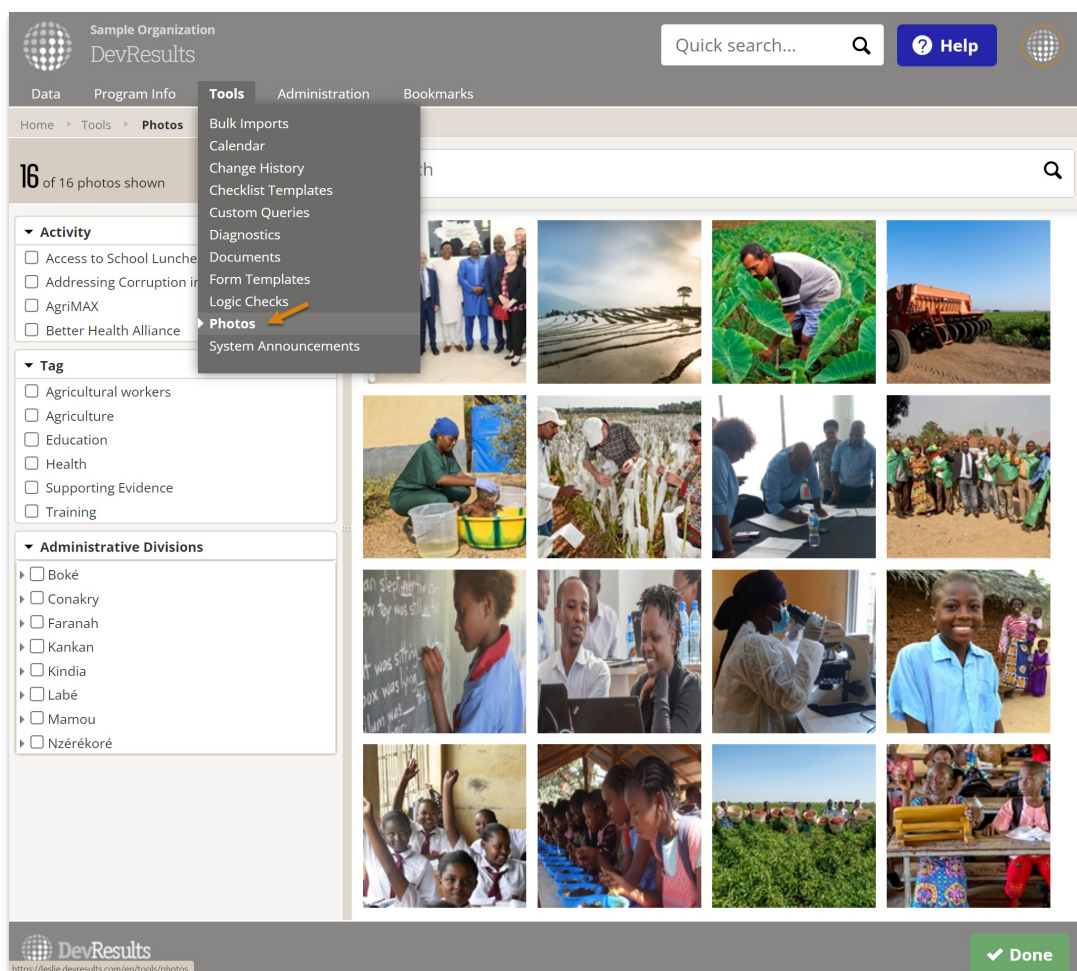

Below the Description section, in the **Geographic Location** section, you can specify the exact latitude/longitude where

the photo was taken, or click on the **Look up location** button to type in a few keywords and attempt to locate the image using a Google Maps search.



To view photos across all activities, go to **Tools > Photos**. This gallery allows you to filter the photos by activity, by geography, or by tag. You can use the search bar to find photos based on text in the caption. Clicking on the thumbnail here will also allow you to edit the details of a photo.
